Logbooks / Job Logs

A logbook / job log is a detailed breakdown of experience in a specific method and sector over a limited period.

As a minimum should contain:

- Limited date range (typically no longer than 1 month) per log entry
- Testing Equipment, Technique, Product, Standard/Code, Duration (hrs)

Generalized summaries shall not be accepted.

Each page of the logbook shall:

- **Identify the name of the applicant and referee**
- **Be signed by the referee**

Notes:

- If more than one referee is applicable, use multiple statements of experience documents to be attested individually.
- Where dates covered by the referee do not cover the full period, multiple referees may be required. If more than one referee is applicable, please use multiple sheets for statement by referee.
- Ensure sufficient detail is provided to cover the scope of your application.

Level 3 Applications

Provide a detailed CV / resume with full details of employment history.

Level 3 applicants must provide details and evidence of a variety of the following elements:

- Establishing Techniques and Procedures
- Interpreting Codes and Standards
- Designating Test Methods
- Interpreting Test Results
- Supervising Level 1 & 2 Activities
- Training and/or Mentoring

Statement, to be completed by all applicants.
